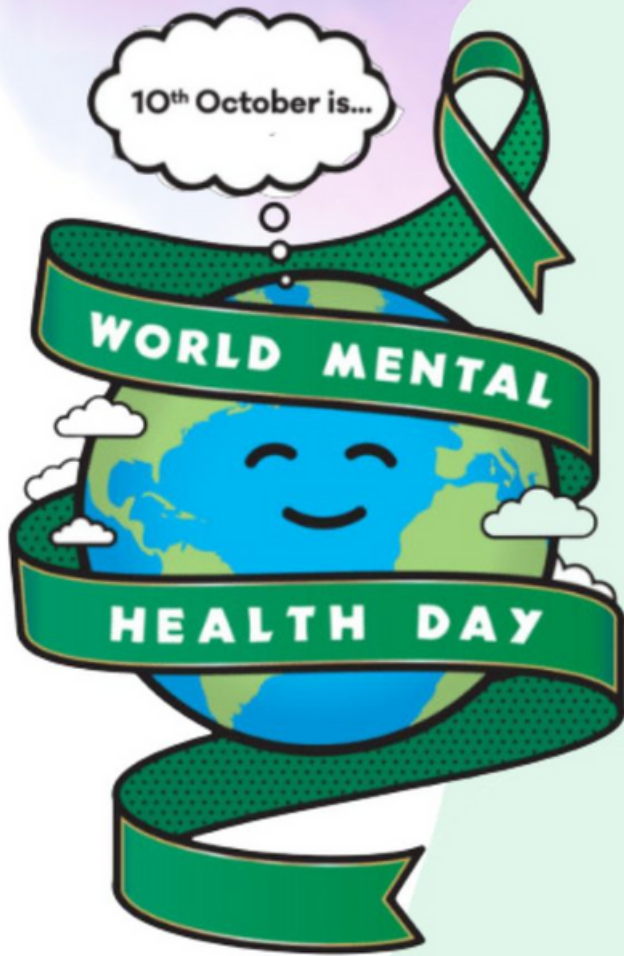

World MENTAL HEALTH Day







10th of October, 2023

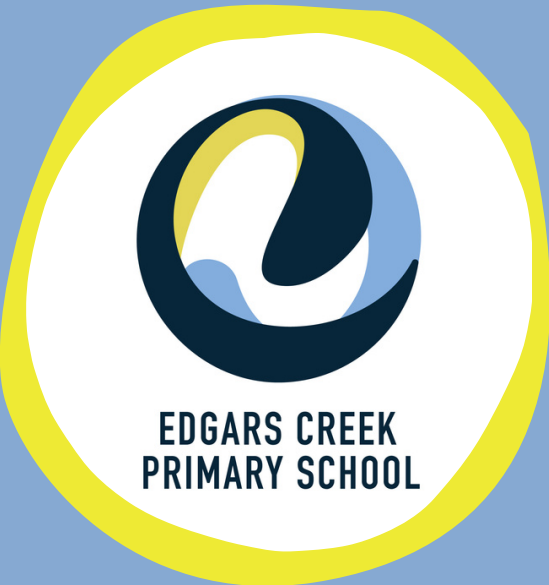
