AUDITIONS ON WEDNESDAY

Edgars Creek Primary School is fortunate enough to have been accepted into the 2025 Victorian State School Spectacular for Mass Dance. This is the first time our school has participated in this amazing event and we are so very excited!

16 of our Year 5 and 6 students will get the opportunity to take part in the program. Students are invited to audition NEXT WEDNESDAY AT RECESS. We will teach the students a simple dance during a recess audition and will select 16 participants (and an additional 4 emergency students). If students want to practise at home, please instruct them to learn ONLY the 1st minute of this dance: https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=C_el3h46_kQ

Students selected must commit to 4 full dance training days (Mar 4, Apr 29, Jun 3, Aug 15), a weekly VSSS recess club, 2 full dress rehearsal days (Sep 11, 12 at John Caine Arena) and the VSSS show day, performing 2 full shows at John Caine Arena (Saturday 13th September 2025). It is an expectation that families will bring/collect their child to/from the venue on the show day. The overall cost per student is around \$140 and includes a VSSS t-shirt and bus expenses.




Look out for the reduced speed limit around schools and slow down to improve safety.

Yellow edge line



A driver must not stop on the side of the road marked with a yellow edge line.

Fire hydrants



1 Metre clearance is required for fire hydrants, fire hydrant indicators or fire plug indicators.

School crossings



- · Look out for flags and crossing supervisors.
- You must stop for anyone waiting to cross, or who has started crossing
- · Please remain stopped until the crossing is clear.

No crossing on nature strips/footpaths




Parking is illegal on nature strips and footpaths.

Double parking



It is illegal to double park at anytime. This affects the fllow of traffic.

Within 10 metres of an intersection



A driver must not stop with any part of their vehicle within 10 metres of an intersection unless signed otherwise.

Stopping across driveways



It is illegal to stop/park across a driveway unless you stay in the car and are there for no more than two minutes and move immediately if required to do so to allow entry or exit by the owner/occupier.

3 Metre gap from white line



At least 3 metres must be left between your vehicle and the centre dividing line to allow other vehicles to pass safely and not obstruct traffic.
